Parents Code of Conduct

Children's sports are supposed to be fun, for the children! Unfortunately, many parents, fans and coaches don't realize that their actions, whether verbal or non-verbal, can have lasting emotional effects on children. Too many children are leaving sports activities because the fun is unfairly taken away by adults. Parents, fans and coaches who follow this simple code can help reinforce what sports are all about...BEING FUN FOR EVERYONE!

Preamble The essential elements of character-building and ethics in sports are embodied in the concept of sportsmanship and six principals: trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, fairness, caring and good citizenship. The highest potential of sports is achieved when competition reflects these "six pillars of character."

As a parent or spectator or Coach I will abide by the following code:

Sportsmanship: I will be a positive role model for my child/team and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for athletes, coaches, officials and spectators.

Trustworthiness: I will learn the rules of the sport I watch, and instill in my child the importance of playing by the rules. I will demand a sports environment that is free from drugs, tobacco, and alcohol and I will refrain from their use at all sports events.

Respect: I will respect coaches and officials and their authority during meets, games and competitions, and not confront or questions coaches during said competitions. I will take time to speak with coaches & officials at an agreed upon time and place.

Responsibility: I will do my best to bring my child to practice on time and inform coaches if he/she will be late. I will respect and return all equipment and uniforms that are the property of the Town of Newport.

Fairness: I will praise my child for competing fairly and trying their best. I will expect fair playing time for my child on his/her team. I will teach my child that doing one's best and skill development is more important than the outcome of the game.

Caring: Demonstrate to your child that you are here for them, and that you care about the fun they're having. It's very important to let children establish their own goals (to play the game for themselves). Take care not to impose your own standards and goals on them. Applaud good plays no matter the team or individual.

Good Citizenship: I will represent the Town of Newport and the League in a positive light. All actions of coaches, spectators and parents reflect upon the town they serve. A good citizen will be an ambassador for the league and town they represent. I will also help support the team on and off the field/court.
